

INTERSTATE 10/WILDWOOD CANYON ROAD INTERCHANGE PROJECT



Project Overview

The City of Yucaipa (City), in cooperation with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and San Bernardino County Transportation Authority (SBCTA), is proposing to construct a new interchange connection on Interstate 10 (I-10) at Wildwood Canyon Road in Yucaipa, California (Project). The purpose of the Project is to improve connectivity and multimodal access in Yucaipa, support planned economic development, enhance goods movement along the I-10 corridor, and improve emergency access and evacuation routes. The Project is needed to improve circulation and access for commuter vehicles and trucks at existing adjacent interchanges, in conjunction with the proposed interchange, as well as improving the overall operations on the I-10 corridor.

What's Happening Now

The proposed Project is now circulating the Draft Environmental Document as part of the Project Approval & Environmental Document phase (PA&ED). The Draft Environmental Document evaluated a No-Build Alternative, and three Build Alternatives: Alternative 1 (No-Build) and three Build Alternatives; Alternative 2 (Diamond Interchange Overcrossing), Alternative 3 (Skewed

Diamond Interchange Overcrossing), and Alternative 4 (Diverging Diamond Interchange Overcrossing).

The Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Assessment (EIR/EA), consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), has been prepared for public review and comment.

Anticipated Project Schedule:

PA&ED – May 2027

Final Design – October 2028

Begin Construction – February 2029

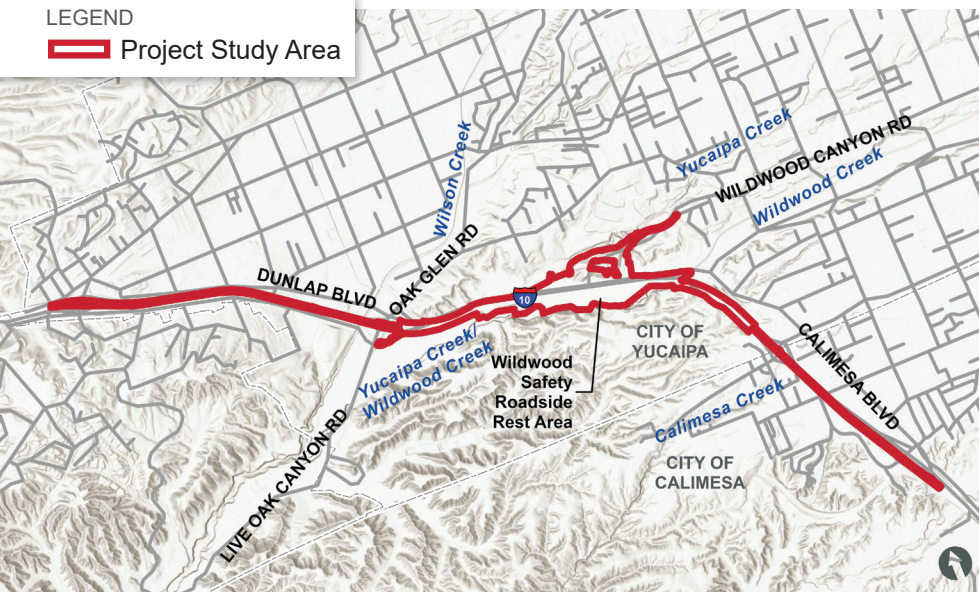
End Construction – December 2030
